



Suggestions for the Use of Golf Carts

- 1.- Parents permission: It must be very clear that the parents are the only responsible for any accident there children may have as well as the damage done to other persons or there properties if they allow them to drive golf carts or any other motorized vehicle in Puerto Aventuras. For this reason we are asking the parents not to allow minors to drive these vehicles.
- 2.- Age limit: The law in the state of Quintana Roo only allows to issue drivers licence to persons who are at least 18 years of age.(previous medical, practical and written exam). To minors 16 and over a provisional permit may be granted with several limitations..
- 3.- Limit to the number of people riding a golf cart: In order to prevent accidents no more that 3 people should be on board of a one seater cart and 6 in the case of a two seater cart.
- 4.- Drive with caution: It's very important to drive with caution and never exceed the speed limit which is 30 Kilometers per hour (around 19 MPH) inside the complex. You must stop at all corners and speed bumps to make sure there is no traffic coming, since there are a lot of large construction vehicles circulating inside the complex. Golf carts and motorcycles are only allowed to circulate in streets and not on in the sidewalks. It is forbidden to toe persons in skates, bicycles or any artifact.
- 5.- Do not drive at night: At night time the golf carts and motorcycles can't be seen unless your unit is equipped with lights and in the case of bicycles, they must have reflective tape in the most visible part of the vehicles.
- 6.- Vehicle registration and identification decals. In order to protect your property, especially now that a golf cart rental company has started its operations in our complex. This way every golf cart circulating will have its own number and this way it will be easier to prevent somebody stealing your cart.. Please go the Colonos Associations office to register your golf cart and pick up you decal (we are giving you free of charge a set of two decal
- 7.- Do not enter the golf course: The golf course is privately owned and we have to treat it with respect and not circulate through it without the proper authorization. A golf course is dangerous because you can get hit by a ball.
- 8.- Do not take the golf cart out of the complex: To take a golf cart outside the complex is not only dangerous but also illegal. Only persons with valid driver license can take the cart outside to fill up the tank at the gas station. Remember a golf cart can't circulate in the federal highway. Its very important that nobody tries to go to the "Super city" convenience store through the gas station. The circulation is one way and driving in the wrong direction can cause a deadly accident.
- 9: Reports of violations to these guidelines to the parents: Any minor who infringes these rules will be reported to his/hers parents. We hope the parents will encourage there kids to abide themselves by these guidelines since the only motivation behind them is to protect the safety off all of the people who live and visit Puerto Aventuras. We also ask you to treat the "security staff" with respect, remember that there work consists in protecting you and your family inside the complex. If you have a complaint about them, please contact the Colonos Association.
- 10.-Driving information at the entrance of the complex. The security personnel at the entrance check point will ask all drivers entering our resort that the have to drive carefully and obey the maximum speed limit at all times, in order to protect the well-being of all the persons living or visiting our resort, very specially the children.
- 11.- Unlawful actions: Taking a cart without the owner's permission is a crime, as well as damaging public and private property. In case of a robbery and/or damages been reported by the security personnel or by eyewitnesses, who ever is breaking the law will be reported directly to the proper authorities. It must be clear that this set or rules only apply as an internal code of rules. In no case is it meant to substitute the law. The persons that don't respect the law do so at there own risk.
